Pencil Pouches for Students in Tanzania, Africa

For each pencil pouch you will need:

- One 9 ½" x 13" piece of fabric (Cotton or cotton/polyester blend fabric. Prints, plaids or any plain colored fabrics are acceptable.)
- One 16" piece of ribbon (1/4" or 3/8" wide. Please choose a ribbon that does not fray at the ends.)
- 4 pencils (or 2 pencils & 2 pens with blue or black ink)
- One 6-inch ruler (plastic or metal with inches and centimeters)
- A pencil top eraser for each pencil (optional)

An alternative to ribbon: Braid 3 pieces of yarn into a finished piece of braided yarn that is 16-inches long (unstretched measurement) including an overhand knot on each side, and trimmed to about ¼-inch beyond the knots on each end of braid (see below).



Notes

- Use 5/8" seam allowances when sewing.
- Finished <u>open</u> pencil pouch is approximately 8 ¼" x 6"
- Finished <u>folded/closed</u> pencil pouch is approximately 8 ¼" x 2"

Instructions:

- 1. Serge each 9 ½" edge of the cut fabric (or turn each 9 ½" edge under ¼" and topstitch).
- 2. Fold the piece of fabric in half, right sides together, with the serged / hemmed edges together (folded to an approximate size of 9 ½" x 6 ¼")
- Sew each of the 6 ¼" sides of the pouch together (using a 5/8" seam).
 Zig-zag or serge along each of these two seam edges to prevent fraying.
- 4. Turn the top (open) edge of the pouch under 1/4" and topstitch.
- 5. Turn the pouch right-side out. Press with an iron, if needed.
- 6. Sew the ribbon (or braided yarn) to the middle of <u>one side</u> of the pouch, backstitching and forward stitching to secure. (IMPORTANT: Be sure you don't sew through both sides of the pouch).
- 7. Place pencils/pens and ruler in pouch. From the open side, fold over one-third of pouch, and then fold over again. Tie ribbon / yarn around folded pouch.
