The outpouring of love we’ve seen from Postcrossers and other people around the world who are sending postcards and other cards for us to hand-deliver to our Tanzanian children is so heartwarming. And the children in our Tanzanian villages who receive these postcards are truly delighted with the pictures on the cards and with the wonderful words of encouragement written just for them.

While the cards are received by the children with such grateful thanks, these children simply do not have the financial means to purchase a postcard and postage stamp to reply personally to the cards they receive. A postage stamp alone costs nearly as much as the average daily income for an entire Tanzanian family. As the 5<sup>th</sup> poorest country in the world, a typical Tanzanian family with 6 or more children struggles to survive on less than \$400 a year – less than \$1 a day.

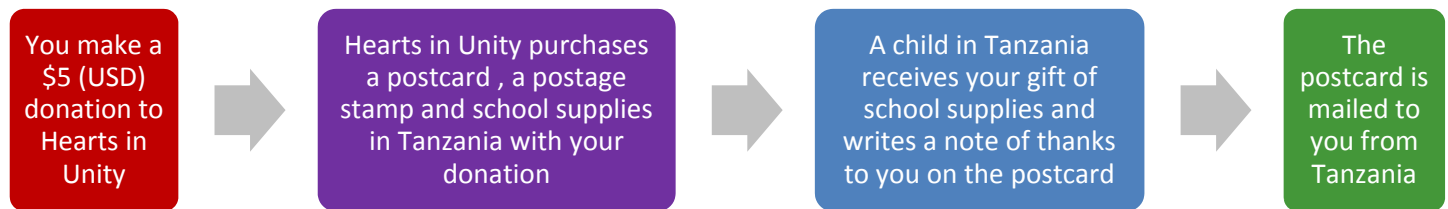
**Yet, we have received so many requests from Postcrossers and other friends of Hearts in Unity around the world to receive a postcard from one of the children in our Tanzanian villages.**

**So we’ve come up with a new project for our friends around the world to receive the postcard from Tanzania that they are seeking, and to help a child in Tanzania at the same time!**

### How does this special project work?

Hearts in Unity representatives from the U.S.A. will be returning to Tanzania again in November 2010. For each \$5 donation you make to Hearts in Unity before October 15, 2010, we will purchase, on your behalf, a postcard, postage stamp and school supplies (pens, pencils, paper/notebook) when we arrive in Tanzania.

From there, we will present your gift of school supplies to a child in one of our Tanzanian villages. The child will then write a thank you note to you on the postcard. We’ll help them with the Swahili to English translation, as needed. Then we’ll mail the postcard to you from the nearest regional post office in Tanzania, Africa.



This limited-time special project allows only for postcards to be sent to you in November 2010 from children in our Tanzanian villages. While they will be most thankful for your gift of school supplies and the opportunity to write a note of thanks to you personally, these children do not have the financial means to maintain ongoing correspondence after receiving your gift.

But in the end, not only will you have received a postcard from one of the precious children in our Tanzanian village, but you will have also helped to support that child’s education through a gift of much needed school supplies. It’s a wonderful gift as an investment into a child’s future, and it means more to them than you could ever imagine.
